

Care and Maintenance

Under normal circumstances, occasional light dusting will keep glass art panels looking clean and fresh. When specific cleaning is needed, we recommend that the outer surfaces of art panels be cleaned only with a high-quality glass-cleaning product that does not contain ammonia or abrasives, or lyes or acids (pH neutral, 7).

Suitable cleaners are made or supplied by companies such as C R Laurence (Sprayway). A soft, dust-free cloth should be used; no paper towels or cloths with chemical softeners. To reduce the likelihood that excess liquid cleaner will adversely affect the ink or film on the second surface of the panel over time, we recommend that the cleaner be applied to a soft cloth, rather than sprayed directly on the panel itself, and that contact with the second surface of the panel be avoided as much as possible.

With these practices in place, the inks printed on LYNNEL glass art panels will remain intact, with a “like-new” appearance for many, many years.

Standard Warranty Language

The undersigned, pursuant to any conditions of any applicable Purchase Order and/or Supplier Subcontract or Purchase Agreement, hereby warrants to the Purchaser that all materials furnished for the abovementioned project are new, unless otherwise specified, and that all materials are of good quality, free from material faults and defects, and are otherwise in conformance with common industry standards for wall coverings. This warranty shall cover all materials provided by Supplier against faulty fabrication or workmanship for a period of ONE year after the date (above) on which substantially all the Supplier’s art panels are installed, or for such longer period of time as may be prescribed and mutually agreed-upon in any applicable Purchase Order, Supplier Subcontract or Purchase Agreement. Supplier further agrees to promptly repair all material faults or defects without charge, including the repair of any damage to surrounding equipment or finishes caused by such defects. Please note that this warranty does not cover any aspect of installation by a third party.

LYNNEL Art to Form can reasonably assure the owner and purchaser that these panels will maintain their aesthetic integrity if properly installed, though the panels are subject to the normal wear and tear typically experienced in common areas and public spaces. Further, we are confident that if the owner follows the care and maintenance instructions provided below, and barring physical damage to the panels, any inks used to print the art images on the PWA will maintain their pigment integrity for a considerable period of time.
