Installing Protective Wall Art (PWA) using Spray-Lock

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. USE THESE INSTRUCTIONS IN CONJUNCTION WITH CS SHOP DRAWINGS.

STEP 1 - PREPARATION

- **1.** Ensure the substrate surface is clean, dust-free, no oils, etc. NOTE: Prime joint compound with latex-based primer.
- 2. Take the necessary precautions to protect surrounding surfaces from adhesive overspray.

GENERAL APPLICATION

- 1. Dry-fit each sheet to ensure proper fit prior to applying adhesive to the substrate.
- 2. Shake can of adhesive vigorously.
- **3.** Hold the spray can 18-20 inches from substrate (adjust distance as needed for a uniform spray pattern). Apply Spray-Lock uniformly to the substrate (coverage should equal 2 sheets per can). This should look similar to a popcorn acoustic ceiling texture.
- **4.** If sections appear thin, lightly apply more adhesive. Refer to the spray pattern photo on the Spray-Lock installation guide provided in each case of adhesive.
- **5.** Wait for the adhesive to "tac" up. This may vary based on temperature and humidity. Proper tac is achieved in 10-20 minutes when adhesive becomes transfer free. Test: lightly touch adhesive there should be no adhesive transfer to your fingers. Follow instructions that are on the adhesive container.
- **6.** Place the Protective Wall Covering to the substrate
- 7. Using a Floor Tile Roller (as seen in photo below), roll from the center of sheet outward using a firm amount of pressure when rolling.
- 8. Clean up any overspray immediately using a damp cloth, while the adhesive is still wet.
